The purpose of such meeting is to clarify issues and answer questions on any matter that may be raised at that stage. The Corporation may, at its option, give such clarifications as are felt necessary.
- c. Pursuant to the pre-bid meeting if the Corporation deems it necessary to amend the Bid Document, it shall be done by issuing Corrigendum. In case of non-receipt of any such intimation, it shall be deemed that the Bidder is satisfied that the document is complete in all respects.

Purpose - Concept of Project Implementing Agency

DEVELOPMENT OF HORTICULTURE FARMING UNDER PROTECTED STRUCTURE IN CLUSTERS FOR URBAN CONSUMERS.

The Department of Horticulture, Government of MP intends to create and develop clusters having high potential for horticulture production in rural areas of the state of MP to overcome the bottlenecks of demand and supply of vegetables/fruits and flowers under various schemes. For this purpose The M.P. State Agro Industries Development Corporation (hereinafter call the Corporation) has been nominated by Government of Madhya Pradesh for this Purpose. The program involves coordinated efforts to enhance horticulture production through increasing productivity and improve nutritional security and income support to the horticulture growers by establishing and managing efficient supply chain. The purpose is to provide a **single window platform**, with support for backward and forward linkages, for creating state of the art horticulture produce supply chain involving producer groups and aggregators.

The Corporation looks for engaging and making tie up with suitable Project Implementing Agencies (here in after as a PIA) from among experienced Corporate bodies / Cooperatives/ Farmers' Organization / Agribusiness Consortium, experienced individual with required net worth etc. for facilitating promotion of horticulture farming around the rural clusters in the state. It seeks Expression of Interest (EOI) from among the reputed players having wide expertise in cluster handling of perishable commodities like fruits and vegetable and having prolonged understanding of agribusiness encompassing fruits and vegetables in accordance with the terms and conditions of EOI. The selected vendor will be entered in to Operation, Management and Development Agreement (OMDA) under the various schemes of Government.

CLUSTER FORMATION :

- Cluster will be Identified by the Department of Horticulture, Govt. M.P.
- Selection of PIA (Project Implementation Agency) will be done by M.P. State Agro Ind. Dev. Corporation (the Corporation) through EOI.
- Selection of Farmers (15-25 acre) by PIA to be verified by the Department of Horticulture through the Corporation.
- PIA will assist in providing financial support through banking institutions.
- PIA will supply all goods and Services in the cluster.
- Supplied goods and services will be verified by the committee formed by the Department of Horticulture.
- Selection of Local Resource Person (LRP) will be done by the farmers of the cluster.
- Government will provide all assistance to the Farmers through PIA
- PIA will provide services like Agronomist, PHM (Post Harvest Management), Marketing, OMD of cluster and for GAP (Good Agriculture Practice) in the cluster.

RESPONSIBILITY OF PIA

A. IN CONTEXT TO SUPPLY OF GOODS :

01. PIA shall be responsible for supply & Erection of protected structure material (Shade net house/ Polly house) as per the guideline* at farmers' field. (*annexure I & II).
02. PIA shall be responsible for supply of micro irrigation system at the selected farmers field.
03. PIA shall be responsible to provide all kind of goods like making and provide bed preparation machine, mulching roll on bed and trellising system (support system).
04. PIA shall be responsible for supply quality planting material to the farmers.
05. If any cluster farmer wants to do all the activities at Sr 1 to 4 above at his own, he will be at liberty to do so. In that case the PIA may charge for the services as detailed in para B below. The amount of such charges will be paid by farmer before getting services in the cluster as decided by PIA but not more than 6 percent of the project cost.

B. IN CONTEXT TO SUPPLY OF SERVICES:

01. Cluster will be identified by the Department of Horticulture Government of Madhya Pradesh.
02. PIA shall identify farmers within area of 25 KM of Cluster with the approval of the Department of Horticulture Government of Madhya Pradesh.
03. PIA shall be responsible for providing awareness and bringing in new advanced techniques of horticulture production in the form of introduction of improved cultivars and new crop species/ varieties, improved production technologies using precision farming, protected cultivation, micro irrigation along with judicious application of INM and IPM techniques.
04. PIA shall be responsible to make the horticulture crop growers aware of the importance of organic farming, Good Agricultural Practices (GAP) and may look for providing training to them on these aspects.
05. PIA shall ensure and encourage participation of educated young farmers around the urban clusters to go and practice for new and vibrant techniques of vegetables/fruits cultivation.
06. PIA shall also act as a moderator for arranging finance for the horticulture crop growers for practicing advanced and specialized hi-tech farming (protected structure) through the different financial schemes offered by the central as well as the state government.
07. PIA shall provide all know how information for protected structure, crop production details in Hindi language in the form of booklet.
08. PIA shall provide free maintenance for 3 year of protected structures and provide insurance facilities for structures on famers' cost. For protected structure tri party agreement will be carried out between farmers, government and PIA (only in case it is supplied and Erected by the PIA).
09. Local Resource Person (here in after called LRP) will be a person who will be selected by the farmers of the cluster with a consent of PIA.
10. LRP shall construct pack house and purchase refer van for cluster farmers. Government will provide 50% assistance on bank ended only.
11. PIA shall also be responsible for training and strengthening of LRP and cluster farmers. PIA shall provide all logistic facilities, pack house, packaging material etc. to cluster farmers.

12. PIA shall purchase cluster produce at average local mandi (average of minimum and maximum rate on the day of purchase) rate from farm gate and will deposit due amount within time limit as per act which will not exceed three days from the date of procurement in the account of LRP through NEFT/RTGS/BANK TRANSFER only. The PIA will enter into an agreement with LRP in such a way that ensures payment to the farmers of cluster, in case of failure of LRP to release payment to farmers PIA will release due payment directly to the farmers and will select another LRP with due consultation with farmers. Recovery proceeding from LRP will be initiated by PIA. The LRP will be responsible to distribute due amount to farmers. He will get 3% commission on final sale proceeds from PIA for sorting, grading and packing of the cluster produce of the farmers. If it is found that the produce received at the sale point is not as per quality norms the difference amount will be recovered from 3 % commission of the LRP and from difference amount payable to farmers.
13. PIA, shall pay to the farmers the difference between actual sale price and farm gate price after reducing expenses like transportation (on actual) , mandi tax, LRP commission (3 percent), weight loss (on actual but not more than 10%), Service charges for Agronomy services to cluster farmers (per farmer) and Service charges for marketing of clusters produce (not more than 10 percent for both) subject to terms and conditions mentioned at 17 of annexure 2 in next purchase of produce. In no case, difference between actual sale price and farm gate price will not be negative.
14. PIA will be lifting only pre-decided quality produce from the cluster. LRP will be responsible for quality production as per requirement of PIA.
15. In case it is found that the LRP supplying produce directly to the market without knowledge of PIA or indulge in mal practice, PIA will have right to inform Government, stop difference payment as clause 10 above. Government will take suitable action against that cluster. LRP will ensure to engage all available infrastructures of cluster farmer, if LRP is not doing so, Government will take action against LRP and/or cluster. Government may also confiscate and give other LRP run it for cluster farmers.
16. PIA has to provide online platform for market information and crop information to cluster farmers.
17. Government has to assure all financial support to the cluster farmers if they needed.
18. PIA will be responsible for providing all above services to aggregator and cluster farmers for three years. Handler has to make an agreement on 1000 Rs. stamp paper for above said services with aggregator and government.

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The Bidding is invited under e-tendering system from experienced Corporate bodies / Cooperatives/ Farmers' Organization / Agribusiness Consortium, experienced individual who fulfils the eligibility criterion as per bidding document.

- A. Bidders are required to read carefully the terms and conditions of the document and s
 - B. Submit documents/ relevant information mentioned in TENDER document which is available on website only after affixing their digital signatures as a token of acceptance.
 - B. Any amendment / amendments in the document including extension of date etc., such amendment / amendments will be uploaded on the Corporation's website www.mpagro.org. & on www.mptenders.gov.in No further notification will be published in the news paper. Therefore, interested bidders are advised to visit Corporation's website regularly for any update. It is also to be noted that any such amendments will be part of the Bid
 - C. The Bidders will have to get registration with www.mptenders.gov.in for e-tendering, without registration Bid cannot be uploaded on portal. To participate in Online TENDER interested Bidder will require Registration at Portal and valid class 3 digital signature certificates. Any charge/fee required for registration by www.mptenders.gov.in is to be paid by Bidder.

1. **BID SUBMISSION:**
 - a. The applicant should pay Rs. 11,800/- through online portal www.mptenders.gov.in. On payment of application fee the tender document can be downloaded from website www.mpstateagro.org. but the application fee is to be paid online only through www.mptenders.gov.in
 - b. All the documents uploaded by the bidder are to be submitted in the form of hard copy duly self-attested, stamped in the Tender Box kept in the horticulture section of office of MPSAIDC Ltd, Panchanan, 3rd Floor, Malviya Nagar, Bhopal before 3 PM on 26.03.2019. The sealed envelope should be super scribed with tender for Supply and Installation of Protected Structure with Micro Irrigation Facilities in Cluster with Goods and Services in Various Schemes of the Government
 - c. Each bidder is eligible to submit only one Bid.
 - d. The Bid will be valid for a period of Three Month (90 days) from the opening of Financial Bid.
 2. **TERMS OF PRICE QUOTE:**
 - a. The RATE is to be quoted in the prescribed proforma through online (i.e., the price bid is to be uploaded through e-portal).

- b. The rate quoted is applicable for “ Supply and Installation of Protected Structure with Micro Irrigation Facilities in Cluster with Goods and Services in Various Schemes of the Government ”
- c. The rate should be FOR destination (identified cluster), inclusive of all taxes. In case of change in taxation (GST) the reverse calculation will be made to arrive on rate.
- d. The rate should be inclusive of Supervision, installation, Insurance, Packing and forwarding.
- e. It is clarified that no other charges will be paid except the rate given in annexure IX (Financial Bid).

3. NEGOTIATION:

It is clarified that normally, no rate negotiation will be done; therefore Bidder should quote their lowest prices only. The Managing Director of the Corporation reserves the right to give counter offer as decided by him to the eligible lowest Bidder or ask all eligible Bidders to resubmit their offers of a plant in closed envelop at such place, date and time as may be determined in this regard (This process shall be called Snap Bidding).

4. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD): Rs. FIVE LACS ONLY

- a. No interest will be paid on Earnest Money Deposit.
- b. The Earnest Money Deposit will be paid online, in the absence of EMD, tender will not be accepted.
- c. EMD will be returned only after work is allotted, agreement signed and necessary Bank Guarantee is submitted as required as per clause 13.
- d. Earnest Money Deposit of unsuccessful Bidder will be refunded as early as possible.

5. OPENING OF TENDER:

- a. The Sealed envelop super scribed with “Supply and Installation of Protected Structure with Micro Irrigation Facilities in Cluster with Goods and Services in Various Schemes of the Government ” (physical copy of the tender) will be received in the office of MPSAIDC Panchanan, 3rd Floor, Malviya Nagar, Bhopal up to 03:00 PM on 26.03.2019.
- b. The uploaded technical bids of tenders will be opened at 04.00 PM on 26.03.2019 in the presence of Bidders or their authorized representatives.
- c. In case, the technical bids are not opened on the schedule date & time, due to some reason, the next date and time of opening of technical bid will be displayed on the notice board of the Corporation or it will be informed to Bidders or their representatives.
- d. The date of opening of Financial Bid of only qualified Bidders will be displayed on the notice board of the Corporation, uploaded on the Corporations WEBSITE and will be informed by email as informed by the bidder as per Annexure XI.

6. PROCESS OF OPENING OF THE TENDERS:

- a. The technical bids received shall be opened on the due date and time as notified. All technical papers submitted therein shall be examined by the Competent Committee. During such scrutiny if any additional information is required, the same shall be asked for.
- b. The Competent Committee shall, while doing scrutiny, refer to both the online documents received and also physical (hard copies) submitted by the bidder.
- c. Such bidders who qualify the technical criteria laid down in this tender shall be notified about the date and time of opening of the financial bids.
- d. The financial bids shall be opened in the presence of bidders or their authorized representative if they chose to represent.
- e. The chart of the price bids received shall be prepared plant wise.
- f. The competent authority shall first examine the rates received and where it considers that revised bids needs to be called for.
- g. If after opening price bids, the competent authority considers the rates to be unreasonable, bids of the same shall be rejected.

7. THE EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD) WILL BE FORFEITED UNDER THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES:

Earnest Money shall be forfeited if the Bid is withdrawn:-

- a. At any time prior to its rejection.
- b. Before or after the acceptance is communicated to the Bidder.
- c. If the successful Bidder fails to execute the agreement within 10 days of date of letter of acceptance.
- d. In case, it is found that the Bidder has given wrong information or submitted wrong documents in the tender, the concerned firms will be De-barred for a period of three years from participation in the tenders called by the Corporation, besides forfeiting EMD.

8. EXECUTION OF AGREEMENT:

- a. Corporation will intimate the successful Bidder regarding acceptance of his offer and inform him to execute an agreement. In case the Bidder fails to execute agreement within time limit the EMD deposited by Bidder shall be forfeited.
- b. The successful Bidder shall have to execute an agreement as per Annexure **XI** with the Corporation. The agreement will be executed on non-judicial stamp paper of Rs. 1000/-, the cost of the same will be borne by the Bidder.
- c. After execution of Agreement the Bidder will be called Project Implementing Agency.

9. PROCEDURE & TIME SCHEDULE FOR EXECUTION OF CLUSTER:

- a. On identification of cluster by the DoH, the PIA will be informed to identify & selection of beneficiaries in cluster within 90 days.
- b. *Selected beneficiaries shall have an option to avail services of PIA for installation of protected infrastructure or selected beneficiaries may create aforesaid infrastructure at their own.*
- c. In case, the supplies/installations are delayed by PIA, the loss caused to the Beneficiary/Department /Corporation due to delay, PIA will be made responsible for which the recovery of the loss amount will be recovered from BANK GURANTEE of the supplier, depending upon the cost of the material. The amount to be recovered will be decided by the Managing Director of the Corporation and it would be binding on the PIA
- d. The Financial assistance (subsidy) provided by DoH will be deposited in farmer's bank account only.

10. ORDER PROCEDURE:

- a. All necessary action to avail Financial assistance (subsidy) provided by DoH will have to be taken care by PIA. After issuance of Letter of intent by DoH, PIA to collect orders/sanction letter from bank and execute installation of protected infrastructure.
- b. Selected **ben**eneficiaries of cluster who wish to install protected infrastructure from PIA will be facilitated by PIA to avail loan from bank if required.
- c. Any damages/ breakdowns or losses caused during transportation of material or loss occurred due to theft, fire accident, breakage etc. the supplier will responsible and will bear the loss and the Corporation will not be responsible. It is advised that Bidder should take necessary insurance coverage.

11. WARRANTY

PIA shall provide free maintenance for 3 year of protected structures and provide insurance facilities for structures on famers' cost. For protected structure tri party agreement will be carried out between farmers, government and PIA (only in case it is supplied and Erected by the PIA).

In case of damage caused by human, animal, natural calamities, fire, flood, theft etc. PIA will have to repair Protected infrastructure at farmer's cost.

12. BANK GUARANTEE (Performance guarantee) :

Cluster will be identified by the department and informed to PIA. PIA will select beneficiaries and after selection the PIA shall have to submit bank guarantee (two BG will be submitted one for 2.5% for supply of goods one for 2.5% for supply of services) at the rate of 5% of work value for each farmer in a cluster. Bank guarantee shall have to be deposited to the Corporation to safe guard of the interest of farmers.

This guarantee submitted for supply of goods will be released on installation of protected infrastructure and inspection of all supplied goods by government while 2.5% of performance guarantee will release after 3 years for supply of services.

13. TENDER OPENING SCHEDULE:

The schedule date for opening of tender is as per the Point B in General Terms & Condition section. In case, above schedule date is announced as a holiday, the next working day will be the date of opening of tender as per schedule time of 04.00 PM.

14. Once the Bidder submits the tender, it is understood that Bidder has gone through all the terms & conditions of the tender and accepted them. The Bidder should sign all the documents of the tender.

15. The Managing Director of the Corporation reserves the right to amend/modify partially/completely or repeal the terms & conditions of the tender if exigencies required doing so without any notice, any time before the bid due date.

16. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES:

Any disputes or differences which may arise between Bidder and Corporation, it is to be amicably settled and the Managing Director of the Corporation will be the arbitrator. If amicable settlement cannot be reached, the court of Bhopal only shall have the jurisdiction to deal with and decide any legal or dispute arising between them.

17. FORCE MAJEURE CLAUSE:

Force losses likewise accidents, riots, break down of vehicle, theft, natural calamities, any act of god etc. in this losses farmer has to bare this losses. In this farmer wont pay any recovery for losses but he shall not get any additional pay.

18. For all legal proceedings, the District Court Bhopal will have jurisdiction.

Instructions to Bidders

1. The Bidder is expected to read carefully all instructions, conditions of Bid Document and its annexure proforma agreement, specifications, and schedules in the Bid Document. Failure to comply with the requirements of offer will be at the bidder's risk. Bid, which is not substantially responsive to the requirements of the bidding document, will be rejected.
2. No Offer shall be considered valid if :-
 - a. It is not submitted in **prescribed bidding document** and **not accompanied with Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)** of amount Rs 5.00 lakh as mentioned in clause 2 of Annexure II online. The offer received without E.M.D. will be rejected at the time of opening itself. **Adjustment of old EMD/SD will not be allowed in any case.**
 - b. The offer is **conditional and inconsistent** with the terms and conditions of the Bidding Document .
 - c. Bid is received after the due date & time fixed for submission of the bid.
 - d. Bid is not submitted with Affidavit as per **Annexure X** on non judicial stamp paper of RS. 500/- duly notarized.
 - e. Bid has not enclosed the relevant forms for ascertaining eligibility criterion.
 - (ii). The process of interpretation, evaluation and comparison of offer and recommendations concerning the award of the contract shall not be disclosed to the Offerer or any other person. **CANVASSING IN ANY FORM SHALL RESULT IN CANCELLATION OF THE OFFER.**
 - (iii). After selection as PIA, the successful bidder is required to execute an agreement with the Corporation on Rs. 1000/- Non Judicial Stamp Paper
 - (iv) **Performance guarantee** : Cluster will be identified by the department and informed to PIA. PIA will select beneficiaries and after selection the PIA shall have to submit bank guarantee two BG will be submitted (one for 2.5% for supply of goods one for 2.5% for supply of services) at the rate of 5% of work value for each farmer in a cluster. Bank guarantee shall have to be deposited to the Corporation/ Department of Horticulture & Farm Forestry to safe guard of the interest of farmers.
 - (v) This guarantee submitted for supply of goods will be released on installation of protected infrastructure and inspection of all supplied goods by government while 2.5% of performance guarantee will release after 3 years for supply of services.

01. Company having 3 years of experience with minimum turnover of Rs 50.00 lac in each financial year and average of Rs 2.25 crore in last three financial years for supply & Erection of protected structure material (Shade net house/ Polly house) (2015-16 to 2017-18). To be supported by a certificate issued by a Chartered Accountant.
02. Company having minimum 2 Agriculture Graduate having post qualification experience of 3 years and in employment of the company for last 1 year.
03. Marks will be given fro criteria as detailed below for selection. Minimum qualifying marks will be 60 ot of 100.
